Making a Splash!

When the garden needs a lift but there's no time to wait, an instant splash of colour will do the trick. Head for the new *Diascia Splash* series – it offers more than just a splash of colour!

Not only immediately colourful, the *Splash Diascias* are both speedy and long lasting. They'll quickly fill their space then carry on blooming throughout

Care Tips:

- Water well to establish.
- Give them an occasional long soak in the dry summer months.
- Feed with slow release fertiliser in spring.
- Trim lightly after the first flush to encourage faster re-blooming.
- Cut back after flowering to maintain a nice, neat shape for the following season.

the long hot summer and autumn. Flowers are so prolific that you'll struggle to see the foliage underneath.

The *Splash Diascias* were bred to be hardy in a wide range of garden situations. In a choice of four fabulous colours, these tough little beauties are ideally suited to the cottage or wildflower style, and make great gap fillers. As a harmonious blend of pinks, or in drifts of a single colour, they'll give a lasting display among shrubs and perennials in a mixed border. Good for splashing around paths and patio areas or spilling over retaining walls, they also grow extremely well in containers. Or try them as a sea of colour around topiary or standard roses.

Being South African in origin, the *Splash* varieties are able to withstand summer conditions well. Despite their dainty looks, they even tolerate wind. These low maintenance plants will, however, thank you for an occasional soak and some feeding

(especially if they are growing in pots) to prolong the incredible flower display. But that's about the extent of the care!

A light trim at the end of the season and a good feed with slow release fertiliser next spring will set the conditions for another fabulous colour splash from early spring right through to late autumn.
